What is tennis elbow?

xtracorporeal Shock Wave Therapy, or ESWT, was first developed 20 years ago as a treatment for kidney stones. Now researchers have found this treatment effective in treating tennis elbow.

When physical therapy, NSAIDS, or rest and ice fail to alleviate this painful condition, doctors have typically used surgery as the next option. However, with ESWT, treatment is applied in only one session, in the doctor's office, lasting only twenty minutes.

Lateral epicondylitis, or "tennis elbow," is a result of repetitive movements of the forearm muscles. You don't need to be a tennis player to suffer from it; tennis elbow is a common workplace or athletic injury.

The primary symptom is pain on the outside of the elbow caused by inflammation of ligaments and degeneration of tissue around the joint. This makes twisting movements and lifting objects particularly painful.

Tennis elbow usually starts out mild and worsens over time. Chronic sufferers can have disabling pain that rarely relents. Reaching and gripping motions, such as in shaking hands or opening jars, is especially painful. Lifting and carrying even a cup of coffee or gallon of milk are also painful for the person affected with this condition.

Signs and symptoms that your pain may be tennis elbow:

- Inability to extend the forearm fully without discomfort.
- Pain caused by lifting, bending the arm or grasping even light objects.
- Trigger point elbow tenderness.
- Recurring pain on the outside of the upper forearm just below the bend of the elbow.
- Pain that radiates down the arm toward the wrist.
- Pain when shaking hands, turning door knobs, or lifting a grocery bag.
- Muscle weakness in shoulder, forearm, and wrist.
- Occasional muscle spasms in lower arm.

Treatment with ESWT

During the session, you comfortably recline while the elbow is placed on a warm water bubble and covered with gel. The injured area is viewed with diagnostic ultrasound. Then, we then deliver tiny little pressure waves or "shockwaves" to the injured area. Healing occurs gradually over the next 6-12 weeks.

My heel hurts every morning

o you suffer with nagging pain in your heel in the morning or in your elbow after playing tennis or working outside? Well you are not alone! Many people suffer with the condition know as plantar fasciitis or lateral epicondylitis (tennis elbow). Plantar Fasciitis or Heel Spur Syndrome is characterized by a sharp stabbing pain in the heel - usually with your first steps right out of bed in the morning - and anytime after standing from a seated position. Unfortunately, it is very common.

Many people have the misconception that they have a heel spur, but that may or may not be the case; plantar fasciitis can occur with or without a heel spur.

The plantar fascia is the connective tissue that goes from the heel to the toes. It becomes contracted when pressure is off the feet, such when as sleeping or sitting down. Upon standing it must stretch out again; that is when micro tears occur.

Treatment Options

Conservative treatment may consist of a shot of cortisone into the inflamed area accompanied by stretching exercises and the use of firm arch supports. Ice should also be applied to decrease inflammation at the end of the day.

Another option available at our office is Extracorporeal Shock Wave Therapy, or ESWT. FDA approved, it is a non-surgical approach to pain relief that is regularly used to cure common problems like heel pain, plantar fasciitis, Achilles tendonitis, tennis elbow, shoulder tendonitis, lateral epicondylitis, and more. The therapy works by targeting shock waves directly to the painful area. This noninvasive procedure typically lasts less than 30 minutes. Extracorporeal Shockwave Therapy is for those who have had pain for at least six months and have tried conservative therapy with no results.

How it Works

ESWT breaks up the scar tissue in the plantar fascia with sound waves. In breaking up the scar tissue, the plantar fascia is enabled to stretch normally again. Healing is usually complete in 2-12 weeks. We see an amazing 90 percent success rate in our office.

Surgery to treat such painful heel or elbow conditions is only 50 percent successful. Highly invasive, surgery is not only risky, but the recovery time can be substantial.

So instead of hobbling out of bed with pain every morning, do yourself a favor and call to make an appointment today. Your feet will thank you for it.

Advanced Toenail Fungus Relief

irst, let me answer the easiest question. No, fungal toenails do not occur due to poor personal hygiene. In fact, you can wash your feet ten times a day and still be prone to getting the dreaded thick and discolored nail.

Now the difficult question to answer is always, "How did I get it?" Everybody has fungus on their toes and fingers. They are living organisms that are part of the "normal flora" of our skin. In other words, they live together with different types of bacteria on our skin. These living fungal organisms usually do not cause any infection. But the fungus is an opportunistic entity. It thrives in warm, moist environments. And, when you injure your toenail by stubbing it, dropping something on it, or even by someone stepping on it, the nail itself lifts up ever so slightly and sometimes comes off all the way. In doing so, the fungus finds a way under the nail and becomes protected by the nail itself. It may then lie dormant for any amount of time.

As it slowly begins to infect the surrounding tissue, gradual change in the nail may not be noticed until several months after the injury. In fact, some people can't even remember a specific incident that caused injury to a toe.

Whatever the reason, fungal toenails no longer have to be the embarrassing part of the body that we hide in the sand at the beach or paint all year round so nobody will see them. Difficulty in treating fungal infections of the nail is due to the infection being inside and under the toenail - not just on top. The treatment must penetrate the hard and thick nail in order to kill the fungal infection. There are a number of treatments available to you. The following are some options depending upon the severity of the fungal infection.



What treatment is right for you?

1. Home Remedies

A few home remedies have been suggested for treating the fungus: Vicks Vapor Rub, vinegar, and even soaking feet in diluted bleach. However, there is no scientific evidence that any one of these is an effective way to cure the fungus. In fact, there have been cases of chemical burns due to the bleach people have tried to use.

2. Topical Treatments

Anti-fungal creams are quite effective for the fungus in athlete's feet but not the fungal infection in the toenail. The over the counter creams are not able to penetrate the thick nail in order to get to the fungus. Your podiatrist's office should be able to offer over the counter topical treatments that contain ingredients that are able to carry the medication through the nail in order to reach the fungus. It may take anywhere from 4-6 months to notice a difference.

3. Prescription Topical

Again, depending on the thickness of the nail, topical applications are difficult to penetrate through to the fungus.

4. Anti-fungal Nail Polish

One should understand that wearing nail polish will cover and suffocate the nail, preventing it from "airing out". However, fungus thrives in warm and moist environments. For those patients who wish to continue wearing nail polish, anti-fungal nail polish is available. Usually it is applied daily for 7 days then wiped off and applied again for another 7 days until the fungus clears out.

5. Oral Medications

The most commonly prescribed oral medication is Terbinafine (Lamisil). This can be prescribed for the thicker nails that haven't responded to other treatments. Liver function tests must be performed before starting the medication because it gets metabolized through the liver. The medication gets to the root of the nail through the bloodstream and allows the nail to grow out healthy and clear of fungus. One tablet is taken daily for at least 3 months, and liver enzymes are monitored throughout the treatment.

6. Surgical Removal of the Nail

For recurring and severe staged fungal toenails, surgical removal of that nail can be an option. The thickened fungal nail can be removed and a topical anti-fungal application can be used as the new nail starts to grow. Because the area of infection is exposed, the topical treatment is able to kill the fungus more effectively.

7. Laser Treatment

Laser treatment is the newest invention in the elimination of toenail fungus. Quick and painless, it has proven effective for the treatment of mild, moderate and severe cases of toenail fungus. The treatment you decide to use will depend upon the severity of the toenail fungus. It is always in your best interest to consult your podiatrist in order to obtain an accurate diagnosis and the best treatment option available to you personally.

Bunions

A common deformity of the foot, a bunion is an enlargement of the bone and tissue around the joint of the big toe. Heredity frequently plays a role in the occurrence of bunions, as it does in other foot conditions. When symptomatic, the area may become



red, swollen and inflamed, making shoes and walking uncomfortable and difficult.

Bunionette (Tailor's Bunion)

A protuberance of bone at the outside of the foot behind the fifth (small) toe, the bunionette or 'small bunion' is caused by a variety of conditions including heredity, faulty biomechanics (the way one walks) or trauma, to name a few.

Hammertoes

Symptoms of hammertoes, which are curled or bent toes, include calluses, blisters, ulcerations, corns, redness and pain. The correction is simple, and can be performed right in the office surgical suite—no hospital required! Patients receive a few stitches and need to elevate their feet for a few days. Most people who fix their hammertoes say if they'd

have known how simple it was, they would have done it years ago!



Neuroma


An irritation of a nerve may produce a neuroma, which is benign enlargement of a nerve segment, commonly found between the third and fourth toes. Trauma, arthritis, high heeled shoes or an abnormal bone structure are some of the conditions that may cause a neuroma. Symptoms such as burning or tingling in the ball of the foot or in the adjacent toes and even numbness are commonly seen with this condition. Those suffering from the condition often find relief by stopping

their walk, taking off their shoe, and rubbing the affected area. At times, you may feel the pain is similar to having a stone in your shoe.

Don't let stress fractures slow you down.

COMMON FOOT PROBLEMS

The metatarsal bones are some of the most commonly fractured (broken) bones in the foot. There are two main types of metatarsal fractures:

Acute fractures - due to an acute (sudden) injury to the foot (commonly dropping a heavy object onto the foot, a fall, or a sporting injury) -a true foot emergency.

Stress fractures - due to overuse, or repetitive, injury to a normal metatarsal bone

A stress fracture is a small crack in a bone. Stress fractures often develop from overuse, such as from high-impact sports like distance running. But if you are a 40 year old woman and have just started a walking/exercise program, you can get them too! They can occur after new footwear, or insufficient rest, or continuing to exercise despite the presence of foot pain. Sometimes metatarsal stress fractures can occur in someone who has an underlying problem affecting the bones such as rheumatoid arthritis or osteoporosis. They can also occur in people who have lost sensation in their feet due to neurological problems, for example diabetes that has affected the nerves in the feet.

Symptoms

- · Pain that develops gradually, increases with weight-bearing activity, and diminishes with rest
- · Pain that becomes more severe and occurs during normal,
- · Swelling on the top of the foot or the outside of the ankle
- · Tenderness to touch at the site of the possible fracture
- · Foot bruising

DO I NEED TO SEE A DOCTOR?

Your doctor may suggest an X-ray of your foot if they suspect a metatarsal stress fracture. However, not all stress fractures show up on X-rays initially. In fact, about half of them never show up on a normal X-ray. Most metatarsal stress fractures can be seen by using a bone scan to look at your foot.

HOW ARE METATARSAL STRESS FRACTURES TREATED?

The goal of any treatment is to help you return to all the activities you enjoy. Following your doctor's treatment plan will restore your abilities faster, and help you prevent further problems in the future.

Rest. Take a break from the activity that caused the stress fracture. It typically takes 6 to 8 weeks for a stress fracture to heal. During that time, switch to aerobic activities that place less stress on your foot and leg. Swimming and cycling are good alternative activities. Remember, however, that you should not do any physical activity on the involved foot or ankle until you consult a doctor.

Protective footwear. To reduce stress on your foot and leg, your doctor may recommend wearing protective footwear. This may be a stiff-soled shoe, a wooden-soled sandal, or a removable short-leg fracture brace shoe

Casts. Stress fractures in the fifth metatarsal bone (on the outer side of the foot) or in the navicular or talus bones take longer to heal. Your doctor may apply a cast to your foot to keep your bones in a fixed position and to remove the stress on your involved leg. Casts are a type of external fixation. To keep weight off your foot and leg, your doctor may recommend that you use crutches until the bone heals.

Advanced Wound Care!

The power of healing begins with relief. If a non-healing wound is keeping you from doing all the things you would like to do, the Beaver Valley Foot Clinic can help you get your life back. Of those patients afflicted with chronic wounds, the majority (approximately 2.5 million Americans) suffer from slowhealing or non-healing lower extremity ulcers.

Ulcers

Ulcers (an open wound) are wounds that have a biological or physiological reason for not healing. If unrecognized or untreated, these wounds can have serious complications. Some of the most common wounds are leg ulcers from a vein problem, foot wounds from diabetes, a bed sores and any infected wounds. If a wound does not heal within a reasonable amount of time, intensive medical intervention is required to enable that wound to heal. There are many types of wounds that become chronic; non-healing after a number of weeks of non-treatment.

Pressure ulcers (bed sores) are a result of part of the body that stays in a single position for a long period of time. Lying in bed or sitting in a wheelchair causes pressure that can cut off the blood supply to that part of the body. We see pressure ulcers on the heels of patients after a long hospital stay because their feet have been lying on the bed all day in the same position.

Venous ulcers are usually the most common type of wounds seen in our office. It usually occurs with those patients that have a history of a blood clot or vein problems as in varicose veins or venous insufficiency (swelling and sluggish blood flow going back up the leg).

Diabetic foot ulcers refer to any break in the skin on the foot of a person with diabetes in which infections can occur. These open areas can be caused by loss of sensation (neuropathy) and/or poor circulation (peripheral vascular disease). Loss of sensation can make a person with diabetes unaware of continuous trauma (injury) caused by ill fitting shoes, improper weight bearing, or hard objects in shoes like pebbles.

Testing

A venous doppler scan would be a beneficial start to evaluate the venous blood flow. If there is poor circulation within the venous system then there is medical help. There is an outpatient procedure done in the office to reduce the back flow of the veins and increase the circulation of the blood going back up against gravity. An arterial doppler is a scan done to evaluate the blood supply getting down to the entire foot including the toes. Off-loading pressure areas of the feet with diabetic shoes and inserts, special padding and elevating the feet on pillows at night while sleeping (place the pillow under calves, not directly under heels) can help reduce the amount of pressure ulcers.

Treatments

There are many simple topical dressings for wounds such as ointments and saline, or as complex as the use of a "silver type" of dressing that stays on for a week under compression wraps. In clinical trials, Apligraf® (created from cells found in healthy human skin) proved particularly effective in the recovery of patients with long-standing, hard to heal venous leg ulcers and diabetic ulcers.

Another option is Dermagraft® which is manufactured from human fibroblast cells derived from human tissue grown in a lab under sterile conditions. It is used for the treatment of full-thickness diabetic foot ulcers greater than 6 weeks duration. Dermagraft® should be used in conjunction with standard wound care regimens and in patients who have adequate blood supply to the involved foot. Oral antibiotics are required for infections and in serious infections IV antibiotics are needed for hospital admissions. This is why it is very important to seek medical treatment early when a wound develops.







As we age, the tissues of our face change. The skin loses elasticity and becomes lax, You lose facial fat and gravity produces the typical jowls, flat cheek and lower eye bags. Muscles also decrease in their size and strength and with loss of bone especially around the upper and lower jaws, the face takes on the typical features of aging. The face assumes a tired sagging appearance.

Environmental factors like sun-damage and pollution (smoking) accelerates the loss of collagen and hyaluronic acid, and causes abnormal pigmentation (sun spots/age spots), fine blood vessels and wrinkles to appear.

The downside of previously available surgery is significant scarring and recovery time lasting for four to six weeks.

We have available minimally invasive techniques for rejuvenating the face in order to provide you with effective facial rejuvenation.

The recent appreciation of the importance of volume loss contributing to facial aging has lead to the increasing use of injectable products/fillers in restoring a more youthful appearance.

The Silhouette Facelift technique uses novel threads of permanent sutures incorporating tiny absorbable cones which lift and reposition the tissues of the skin. These Silhouette Sutures have been approved by the FDA in the USA and have received the CE mark of approval.

The threads are secured to the deep strong fibrous tissue in the temple region ensuring that the lifting of the sagging tissues is long lasting. Normally four threads are used on each side of the face and two to three are used on each side of the neck. The Silhouette Facelift normally takes 90 minutes and treatment of the face and neck takes 60 minutes. The cones dissolve over a period of three to four months leaving the sutures to lift

The Silhouette Facelift procedure is designed to rejuvenate the lower face and neck with a minimally invasive procedure that is performed under local anesthetic as an outpatient. No hospital stay is required and the recovery time is normally three to five days.

The ideal patient for the Silhouette Facelift procedure is 35 to 60 years of age with early jowls and sagging of the cheek and neck, who does not have significant skin laxity and who would like to restore a fresher, more youthful appearance, but wants to avoid the risks and downtime of a standard facelift procedure.

However, in combination with the Silhouette Facelift procedure, several other non-surgical or minimally invasive treatments or procedures may be suitable to achieve the optimum rejuvenation of the face.

Liposculpture and

s we get older or have children, the body tends to remap the areas where it deposits most of the excess fatty tissue. The flanks, lower abdomen and thighs become common targets in women; the abdomen flanks and chest in men. Unfortunately, losing sufficient weight to clear fullness in these areas commonly leads to excessive volume loss in the face, giving it a tired expression. In some people, even at a young age, there are stubborn fatty tissue deposits, mostly around the thighs, which seem to be genetic.

Liposuction is the removal of fat from deposits beneath the skin using a hollow stainless steel tube called a cannula and a powerful vacuum. A procedure chosen by both men and women, it is not a method of weight reduction. Rather, it is a way to remove stubborn fatty deposits that remain despite dieting, exercise or massage.

In the early days of liposuction, the procedure involved using relatively large cannula and was associated with extensive bruising and a higher risk of irregularities. Today, liposuction uses much finer cannula that cause less trauma to the tissues and allow fat to be removed in a much more controlled manner. These finer cannula can be used closer to the skin surface to provide a superior result.

Amorerecent addition to the armamentarium of body sculpting surgery, is the impressive Custom Acoustic Liposuction or "Tickle Lipo". It allows for a carefully controlled and gentle surgical process to loosen and remove areas of fatty tissue deposition and can be used just as safely around the face, neck, body and arms and legs. During your consultation you surgeon will ask about your general health, any conditions that might interfere with liposuction, your goals for the surgery and the specific areas where you want fat removed.

It is important that you discuss your goals fully with your surgeon so he can advise you as to whether the results will meet your expectations. He may tell you that you could require more than one liposuction session to achieve your goals without unacceptable risk. Your surgeon may also recommend an alternative procedure such as a tummy tuck, if the abdominal skin has become too loose. If you have loose skin and/or dimpling (cellulite) you are probably not an ideal candidate for liposuction. Indeed, liposuction could make these conditions worse. In these situations, abdominoplasty, thigh lift or body lift may be a better procedure for you. As part of your consultation, your doctor will perform an exam, explain the details of the procedure and develop a specific plan for surgery and recovery with you.

In most cases you surgeon will require that you be relatively close to your ideal body weight. This is not an absolute requirement. Rather, it reflects the fact that there is a surgically safe limit to the volume of fat removed that can be removed at any time, and a limitation on how much your skin will shrink after large volume liposuction.

For these reasons, if you are contemplating liposuction as part of a more extensive diet and exercise program aimed at losing more than a 20 pounds of weight, your surgeon will recommend that you lose the weight before your surgery. It is fair to say that the results of liposuction often motivate people to adopt better diets and more extensive exercise, however you should not rely on making these changes after your procedure.

If you have enough donor fat, our Dr. prefers to augment the butt using fat injections-the Brazilian butt lift. He believes that this method results in the most natural and sensual look for the buttock area. He only recommends butt implants if you are

very tiny with no fat in your stomach or flank area. The fat transfer method has a lower risk of infection compared to the butt implant procedure.

An additional benefit of this fat injection method is that you not only get a more shapely buttock, but the area liposuctioned is now much leaner, giving your profile a more sensuous look.

How is the fat injected into the buttocks?


The buttock is first contoured by performing liposuction in the areas around the buttocks to make them stand out more. Common areas liposuctioned include the back-directly above the butt, the stomach, and the thighs. Note that even the liposuction alone will give your lower body a more attractive look.


The fat suctioned from these areas is carefully processed and purified such that only a fraction of the donor fat removed will qualify for re-injection to the buttocks. In order to get enough qualified fat, the doctor must liposuction at least 2 areas of your body. After liposuction, he carefully purifies the fat so that only the best donor fat cells are reinjected back into your buttocks for augmentation. The fat is placed or transferred to the buttocks with special cannulas.

The doctor injects small amounts of purified fat into different areas of the buttocks and at various depths so that the patient will get the highest permanent absorption rate. Correct injection methods are essential to achieve a uniform, smooth, natural appearance to the buttocks

How long do the fat injections last?

If the fat is harvested, processed, and injected correctly, the result should be long lasting. The procedure should not require touch ups or a second round of fat injections. The Brazilian butt lift result is highly dependent upon the experience of the surgeon. Surgeons who are not using correct purification or injection methods will not obtain long lasting results. 🖋

Lip Color and Lip Liner

This procedure is both lip liner and lipfill. The vermilion border, or lip line can be tattooed slightly outside the border to give the appearance of larger, more pouty lips. As time marches on, our lips begin to appear thinner, irregular, and faded. The lips take a lot of wear and tear and it is little wonder that as we mature, women want plump, colorful, well-defined lips, which we enjoyed in our youth. Over time, sun damage, medical conditions, hormonal changes, and tissue trauma all contribute to loss of definition and natural color. Lip Liner

Permanent evebrows help normalize a person's lifestyle and/or put a traumatic event, such as an accident or medical condition behind them.

Eveliner

As stated so often, the eyes are the "window to our soul". People often refer to another's eyes as sexy, thoughtful, tired, cheerful, lifeless, or heaven forbid, beady, and so on. Our eyes define how we feel inside and how life is treating us. They are our means of projecting thoughts without words. Because our eyes are so expressive, it must be why we

want the area surrounding the eye to look its best at all times. If we are in other's company, our eyes are the focus of conversation. With eyeliner the lash line is darkened to produce a lush, full lash-line effect. This can be applied to either the upper, lower or both lash-line areas. Eyeliner, properly selected takes the "tired and washed out" appearance out of our expressions, as well as the entire face. Sports activities, hobbies that were avoided due to the fear of topical makeup coming off, and just simply looking your best at all times are yours for the asking.

Evelash Enhancement

Eyelash Enhancement brings out the eyes just like eyeliner does. A line is drawn or dots are placed between the lashes, which gives the illusion of fuller lashes. The color used is typically the same color as your lashes.



Quit Smoking

Laser Smoking Cessation

o, you have decided that it's time to quit smoking! The mounting social stigma, increasing cost, and concerns about the effects of smoking on your health have finally gotten you to give in and give up. According to Mark Twain, "Quitting smoking is easy, I've done it hundreds of times." Okay, so it's not so easy, but laser therapy can help!

Google 'quitting smoking' and you will find numerous sites offering any number of different therapies that promise to help you stop smoking for good. These range from acupuncture and hypnotherapy to books and relaxation techniques. Other options include nicotine patches, gum, and



inhalers, but you are still addicted to nicotine. Medications are another option, but are expensive or have potential side effects. Although some people may find these techniques work for them, the overall success rate is only about 5%.

A new low level laser therapy option is now available that could be just right for you! Low level cold lasers have been used for years to stop pain and recently to help people quit smoking. Low Level Laser Therapy is the application of red and near infra-red light over injuries or lesions to improve wound and soft tissue healing, reduce inflammation and give relief for both acute and chronic pain.

First developed in 1967, it is now commonly referred to as LLLT (Low Level Laser Therapy). LLLT can be used instead of needles for acupuncture and is ten times more effective for smoking cessation than patches, gum, or hypnotherapy according the results from two NHS trials in Scotland. Laser smoking cessation therapy is a painless therapy that relaxes the body like acupuncture but without the needles. The red and near infrared light (600nm-1000nm) commonly used in LLLT can be produced by laser or high intensity LEDs. The intensity of LLLT lasers and LED's is not high like a surgical laser. There is no heating effect. There are normally no adverse effects from LLLT, however, patients occasionally experience mild discomfort / ache after treatment. This should settle down after 24 - 48

Your body gets rid of nicotine in as quickly as 48 hours after your last cigarette. This means that your withdrawal symptoms can be intense for the first two or three days, but you will feel better after the third or fourth day. Trying to cut down gradually just prolongs the withdrawal process. Most people can't get past that third or fourth day. Laser smoking cessation therapy will reduce withdrawal symptoms in those critical first four days, and control cravings for even longer, resulting in a documented success rate of 46%. Stopping smoking can be difficult but it's not impossible - it all depends on how motivated you are. Make a plan of action for stopping smoking - and stick to it. Tell your friends and family that you're trying to stop smoking, and get their help and support. Stay positive and remind yourself of what you've achieved when the going gets tough. Don't give up on giving up! Stopping smoking involves changing your lifestyle, habits and getting rid of an addiction you may have had for years.

Now that you have made the decision to quit, consider laser smoking cessation therapy to greatly improve your odds of being successful. Quitting is a challenge, but it's worth it.

Blood goes to your legs through arteries, and returns to the heart against gravity in your veins. When you're walking, the muscles in your legs help to pump the blood toward your heart. Valves in the veins keep the blood from leaking back in between contractions. If these valves are not working properly, they leak and increase pressure like a backed up sink, blood then pools in the legs. The veins swell and weaken (varicose veins).

Without Treatment

Varicose veins don't get better without treatment; they slowly get worse over time. Left untreated you may get:

Venous Stasis Dermatitis - Brown or

Phlebitis - Inflammation or blockage of your veins and calves become painful and

Venous Ulcers - Blood products leak out of the varicose vein into the surrounding tissue causing the tissue to weaken over time and break open

Bleeding - Veins can bleed if you shave or bump your leg. You should lie down and raise your leg. Apply pressure to help stop the bleeding

Varicose veins are easy to see in your leg. However, to work out the position and extent of any valve damage that you have, we perform some tests including the following:

- · Color duplex ultrasound scanning is used to look for any abnormalities in the structure of your vein, and to look at the blood flow through it.
- A Doppler test is an ultrasound technique that uses sound waves to produce an image of the inside of your leg. This gives your doctor information about the direction of blood flow in your vein and whether your valves are working properly.



Treatment of Varicose Veins

If your varicose veins don't cause you any discomfort, you may decide not to have any treatment. If you do decide to have treatment, we will explain your options and develop a personal treatment plan best for you. The most common treatment options are listed below.

Compression Stockings

Compression stockings may relieve the swelling and aching of your legs but they won't prevent more varicose veins from developing. Compression stockings can help the blood in your veins to flow up towards your heart, and some people won't need any other treatment.

Sclerotherapy (liquid or foam)

This involves injecting an agent into your smaller veins which irritates the veins, causing them to close. Liquid sclerotherapy is often used to treat smaller varicose veins. For larger veins, foam sclerotherapy is sometimes used. Studies have shown that this treatment is effective at treating varicose veins in the short-term. It is useful on the veins around your eyes, on the hands, thighs, and lower legs.

Endovenous Laser Treatment or Radio Frequency Ablation

Radio Frequency involves using a high frequency energy wave to heat the wall of your varicose vein, causing it to close. These are very safe quick in-office procedures causing minimal local discomfort. There is no down time, and you are encouraged to walk and resume normal activity immediately. The benefits are enormous, relieving symptoms and swelling and decreasing further worsening of your legs. You have ten miles of veins in your body. By simply rerouting the flow in a small section of them, your symptoms will greatly improve. This also allows nonhealing ulcers around the ankle to close and help prevent their reoccurrence.

External Laser Therapy

Removes / cleans up small cosmetic spider veins after the larger problematic ones are cared for. This is used on the face, broken capillaries on the nose, thighs and lower legs!

What You Can Do At Home

Walk regularly and lose excess weight, elevate legs when resting, and use compression stockings. Also do not sit or stand for long periods of time. Don't cross your legs when sitting. There are NO effective medications, or creams that prevent or help varicose veins. Unfortunately the leading cause of Varicosities is genetics, so once they appear, it is best to come in and have them evaluated by a Vascular Lab accredited by the American College of Radiology (ACR) such as the Advanced Vein Center, where we strive to use the latest technology to treat you in the most safe and comfortable manner, by experienced Board Certified doctors specializing in the care of veins. 


