

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

knew that I wanted to be a part of it," says Dr. Teimouri.

After earning her four-year degree, she attended the prestigious Ohio College of Podiatric Medicine, where she took courses identical to those taught in medical schools, studying anatomy, physiology, surgery, radiology, general and sports medicine, orthopedics, neuroanatomy, biomechanics, and dermatology, working in the cadaver lab, and learning methods of casting and splinting.

Following that, Dr. Tina completed a podiatric surgical residency at the Beaver Medical Center, performing over 600 orthopedic, general, vascular, dermatological, and plastic surgical



foot procedures, working in the ER, then practiced for several years to achieve board certification.

She opened the Beaver Valley Foot Clinic in Hopewell in 1994, and soon added several more locations. Licensed in Pennsylvania to treat soft tissue below the knee, and bones from the ankle down, she also provides geriatric foot and nail care, treating diabetic thick and/or ingrown toenails, as well as warts, ganglion cysts, neuromas, neuropathy, corns and callouses, ankle sprains, broken bones, stress fractures, heel spurs, tendonitis, hammertoes, and bunions, with a special interest in the care of lower leg and foot wounds.

In addition, she performs cryosurgery and extracorporeal shockwave therapy (ESWT), an advanced plantar fasciitis treatment for heel spur syndrome; and with her state-of-the-art diagnostic and ultrasound equipment, provides Doppler vascular exams accredited by ACR, the American College of Radiology and digital X-rays.

Dr. Tina also specializes in the care of diabetic wounds, non-healing ulcers, and neuropathy, always stressing the importance of early treatment, even for corns, ingrown toenails, splinters, crooked toes and other things that seem small but can cause big trouble for diabetics, who are highly susceptible to infections. Still, she says that many ignore nascent problems, either because they're afraid of what their diagnoses will

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

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ESWT Help for Heel Pain!

NON-INVASIVE • NON-SURGICAL

Plantar Fasciitis, Heel Spur Syndrome, whatever you call it, it hurts! So, what exactly is it?

The plantar fascia is a thick, supportive tendon in the bottom of your foot which connects your heel to your

toes. When inflammation occurs in this tendon, it is referred to as Plantar Fasciitis. It's the most common cause of heel pain, and is characterized by a sharp and shooting pain in the heel or arch of foot, often most noticeable with the first few steps of the day. Luckily, Beaver Valley Foot Clinic offers effective and state of the art treatment options to help heal that heel pain for good!

Conservative Treatments Options

For mild cases of Plantar Fasciitis, several conventional methods are available. Often used in conjunction with one another, they can both relieve heel pain and stop it from returning.

- Stretching exercises taught by a trained podiatrist
- Applying ice to the tendon to decrease inflammation
- NSAIDS, such as Ibuprofen or Naproxen taken as directed by a podiatrist or physician
- Cortisone or non-cortisone anti-inflammatory injections, which should only be administered by a trained podiatrist
- Night splints, which hold the foot at a 90 degree angle and gently stretch the plantar fascia throughout the night

Extracorporeal Shock Wave Therapy (ESWT)

For those who don't find relief from conservative treatment methods, Extracorporeal Shock Wave Therapy (ESWT) is a safe, effective and a non-surgical option. ESWT is a one-time, 18 minute, in-office ultrasound guided orthotripsy procedure used to treat chronic plantar fasciitis, achilles tendonitis and even epicondylitis (tennis elbow).



How it works: ESWT uses ultrasound guided shock waves (pressure waves) to break up the painful scar tissue found where the plantar fascia attaches to the heel bone. It's a non-invasive treatment and typically takes only about 15 minutes! Prior to treatment, Dr. Teimouri will administer a local numbing agent. Once completely numb, the ESWT therapy device is placed over targeted area and treatment begins. During treatment, micro-trauma is introduced to the plantar fascia. By introducing this extremely controlled fresh injury, the tendon is able to begin the re-healing process over the next 3 months. While ESWT has a very high success rate of over 90%, conservative treatments, such as wearing arch supports and stretching daily, are still recommend.

ANTIFUNGAL NAIL POLISH

Wearing nail polish is often a go-to for women suffering from toenail fungus. Unfortunately, regular
nail polish covers the nail, suffocating it, and traps in moisture, which is the perfect environment for
fungus. Luckily, there is an alternative. Antifungal nail polishes offer the look of regular nail polish but
coat the nail, making it resistant to fungus. Antifungal nail polishes should be reapplied within 4-5
days for maximum effect.

TOPICAL ANTIFUNGAL MEDICATIONS

Don't be fooled, not all topical medications are made equal. Over-the-counter
topicals are not strong enough to penetrate through thick toenails. Podiatrists'
offices offer stronger topical antifungals which penetrate the toenail and work to kill
the fungus. It should be noted that even with the stronger topical treatments, you
will not see a noticeable difference in the appearance of your nails for 6 months, as
the toenails grows out slowly.

ORAL ANTIFUNGAL MEDICATIONS

Oral antifungals may be prescribed by your primary care physician
or a podiatrist. Lamisil is the most common. Prior to taking Lamisil,
your PCP or podiatrist will order testing, as it can alter liver function.
Lamisil comes in a pill form. Once ingested, the medication gets into
the bloodstream, travels to the nail root, and kills the fungus. This
medication should never be taken without approval from your PCP
or podiatrist.

PERIODIC DEBRIDEMENT BY A PODIATRIST


Periodic debridement of the nails is a safe and effective option for
patients with diabetes, those with poor circulation, those who are on
blood thinners, and for the elderly. Fungus causes the toenails to
grow abnormally and very thick, which can be painful. Most
insurance companies will cover debridement, and podiatrists
recommend this service to those who are unable to safely cut their
toenails at home.

PERMANENT REMOVAL BY A PODIATRIST

 If you are beyond caring what your big toenail looks like, and it just hurts, this is your best option! No nail, no fungus. Removal is the only permanent method of getting rid of fungus, anything less requires some type of maintenance.







DYSPORT VS. BOTOX

A group of 90 women, with an average age of 54, were asked to rate the severity of their lines on a scale of 0 to 5. Then, using equivalent amounts of each product,

one-half of each woman's face was treated with Botox while the other half was treated with Dysport.

Then in a follow up study, Xeomin and Botox faced off. After one month each patient was again asked to rate the severity of their wrinkles. Of critical importance was the "double-blind" nature of the study--neither the treating doctors nor the

participants knew which product had been used on which side.

The results were straightforward: as a group, the participants preferred Dysport. When contracting the muscles around their eyes as much as possible, 2 out of 3 patients rated their wrinkles as less noticeable on the side treated with Dysport. When patients fully relaxed their facial muscles, no difference was noted. While both the study itself and the side-to-side differences were small, the split-face study did represent a true face-off, as it was funded equally by the manufacturers of both products. Xeomin outperformed Botox in its study as well.

Ultimately, it's important to remember that who performs your injections is more important than which product they're injecting. Results are temporary, but they still affect your face so experience is indispensable. "You want someone who does this all the time, who knows where and how much to inject," says Beverly Hills plastic William surgeon Dr. Binder, who has performed tens of thousands of injections. Many physicians recommend starting injections between 20-25 years old, although it's never too late to start.

What to Do When Wounds Won't Heal: Two Patients Share Their Stories

Three years ago, Mary D. was worried about something most of us take for granted. "I was starting to have trouble walking. Lots of it." For Mary and many others like her, ulcers and other types of non-healing wounds are some of the most frustrating and frightening health problems they'll ever face. Much as it sounds, they are chronic by nature, and can persist for months or even years.

The idea of a wound that won't heal seems foreign to most of us. After all, most minor cuts resolve themselves in about a week, and even deep surgical incisions usually heal completely. For some patients however, especially diabetics, those with long-standing vein problems, and those over 60, dealing with chronic wounds is a daily struggle. Infection is a constant threat, and this type of wound often hurts badly: about 6 out of 10 chronic wound patients report pain as one of their main symptoms.

Pittsburgh based podiatrist Dr. Christina Teimouri has been a podiatric surgeon and general podiatrist for over 23 years, and has received advanced training in wound care during her residency at Beaver Medical Center. She has helped hundreds of patients with wounds that refuse to heal on their own, and here are two "case studies" that stand out in her files.

"I feel like she saved my toe, and possibly my foot."

Joy G's story came to a head on New Year's Day, 2016. Two years earlier, she had started to develop what seemed to be a large scratch on the bottom of her right big toe. It kept getting worse, and by January 1st she simply couldn't wait any longer. She made the trip to the emergency room, and was started on IV antibiotics immediately since the wound had become badly infected.

Shortly after her discharge things got even worse. What she hadn't realized was that her toe had progressed well beyond a simple infection and had, in



fact, become gangrene. She needed to find a podiatrist, and by sheer coincidence drove by Dr. Teimouri's daily on her way to work. "Dr. Tina made me feel comfortable right away. She was so professional and kind."

Joy's initial appointment was the start of a four week process that ultimately solved a problem that had been brewing for years. It quickly became obvious that the ER doctors hadn't cleaned the wound correctly, and pieces of debris were still inside. She needed advanced wound care on a weekly basis, and "there wasn't a single time I had to come that she couldn't fit me in." Treatment consisted of keeping the wound impeccably clean and using a specialized dressing known as Acticoat, which is an ideal solution for wounds with a history of infection. It contains silver, which is not only a precious metal but kills most germs on contact. After about a month, healing was nearly complete and Joy's life had virtually returned to normal.

"I was ready give up hope. Now I'm back at 100% and can walk a whole lot better."

Now returning to Mary B's story. "It started slowly, a few years ago. I went to so many people, including three foot doctors, and nobody could help." Mary had been an insulin dependent diabetic for over 40 years, and as any podiatrist knows, diabetes complicates almost all foot conditions—even if it's well controlled (see article on previous page). In Mary's case, decades of high blood sugar levels had damaged the small arteries in her feet, gradually causing circulation problems which led to severe ulcers. Unfortunately this type of scenario isn't uncommon in diabetic patients, and according to Dr. Teimouri "it's essential that all diabetics work with a podiatrist they know and trust."

Over the course of 2 years, Mary had developed severe ulcerations on both the ball of her foot and the heel. Any chronic diabetic ulcer is serious, but in Mary's case their location had turned an already bad situation into an ongoing crisis. After a certain point, walking hurt so badly that for all practical purposes it had become impossible.

In complex cases like this, an individualized approach works best, and frequently even dedicated wound care centers aren't up for job. Mary had already experienced this herself: she had gone to one previously, "but it just wasn't working. I wasn't getting worse, but I wasn't getting any better either." Seemingly out of options, Mary gradually began to accept the fact that she might never walk normally again.

She had almost given up entirely when she started seeing Dr. Teimouri. "They got me in right away, they're really nice people. And Dr. Tina knew exactly what she was doing."

In Mary's case, diabetes had damaged her circulation to the point where the blood flow to her foot was only a small fraction of what it should be. The skin around the wound was so damaged that it couldn't even begin to heal on its own without a painstakingly applied collagen coating, which acted like a scaffold for new skin to latch onto and grow. After several visits, "it started feeling so much better. Now I won't go anywhere else."

If a person has any sort of non-healing wound on their foot or ankle, whether it's related to diabetes or not, seeking a podiatrist's help is critical. This isn't something that will go away on its own, and will only get worse over time. Patients like Joy and Mary are proof that even in the most advanced cases complete healing is still possible. Take Back Your Legs

Look and feel better in about an hour.

If your legs don't look and feel like they used to, then this article is for

you. It contains specific information on what you can do, starting today, to successfully resolve problems you may have had for years. Specifically, we're talking about painful, tired, swollen legs, which can range from merely annoying to nearly debilitating. For some patients these symptoms are constant, and can develop into the type of frustrating medical situation that only seems to get worse with time. Other symptoms are somewhat less common, but also tend to be chronic and resistant to treatment. These include abnormal sensations such as itching and burning,

frequent cramping (especially of the calves), restless leg syndrome, and even severe ulcers which can easily become infected and may never heal completely. If you experience symptoms like these on most days, it's important to remember

that help is readily available—in fact, many patients are amazed that problems years in the making can be solved so quickly and easily.

Chronic Vein Disease: the underlying cause.

It isn't obvious, but all of these symptoms are caused by underlying vein disease. While it's certainly true that visible, ropey varicose veins are a direct result of vein problems, most significant vein disease occurs about 1 to 3 inches below the surface.

Exactly what happens is this—the one-way valves which keep blood flowing in the right direction become damaged and stop working. Blood begins to pool in the legs, and the veins themselves begin to stretch out just like a water balloon as more water is added.

Ultimately the above symptoms develop. It's easy to see how excess fluid collecting in the legs leads to swelling. This swelling creates pressure, which hurts and can range from a mild, dull ache to more severe, stabbing pain. Going further, your muscles begin to work differently under higher pressure, and cramping and restless leg syndrome can develop. If abnormal fluid collection goes on long enough, the skin can break down, resulting in ulcers. This isn't to say that all vein disease is located below the surface—unsightly, bulging varicose veins and purplish clusters of spider veins are extremely common. They aren't usually medically serious, but bother many patients enough to seek treatment. Fortunately, surface veins like these are usually even easier to treat than deeper ones.



Minimally Invasive, State-of-the-Art Treatments:

Modern treatments have advanced to the point where the underlying vein disease can be treated extremely effectively. All treatments are performed in our own offices, with virtually no downtime. Most importantly, these treatments are so safe and effective that older procedures such as vein stripping simply aren't performed anymore. First, it's important to realize that many of these treatments either close down the diseased veins completely or remove them entirely. This causes absolutely no problems whatsoever, and doesn't affect overall circulation at all. In fact, it's exactly what's needed. These diseased veins aren't working properly anyway, and blood is immediately rerouted to nearby healthy veins. Again, since each leg contains literally miles of veins circulation issues are never a problem.

Endovenous Ablation: closing down diseased veins.

By far the most common modern vein procedure is endovenous ablation. In this case "endo" means "inside," and "ablation" means "to collapse or close down."

Much as it sounds, the diseased vein is shut down from the inside, and is naturally absorbed back into the body. From a technical standpoint, this procedure is extremely efficient—in many ways it's the opposite of older procedures, which removed diseased veins through large incisions and often required general anesthesia and a hospital stay.

Scarring was often extensive.

In contrasts, ablation only requires a single, tiny incision at the ankle to access the vein. A specialized, ultra-thin catheter with a heating element at the tip is



then fed into the vein. This tip is quickly heated, the catheter removed, and the vein collapses behind it. Local numbing medication ensures that the procedure is painless—most patients report only a mild sensation of pressure during treatment. No driver is needed, normal activities can be resumed immediately, and aftercare is limited to wearing compression stockings for about a week. Most importantly, ablation has a very

high success rate at eliminating symptoms such as painful, heavy, swollen legs and is extremely safe. Scarring is non-existent in the majority of cases.

Microphlebectomy: safely removing varicose veins.

Visible varicose veins are treated with another minimally-invasive procedure known as a microphlebectomy—the term "micro" means "small," and "phlebectomy" simply means that the vein is removed. This uses only a local numbing solution, and more often than not patients report no pain whatsoever. Micro-incisions are made above the vein, and specialized, miniature tools easily remove the vein. It's important to realize that these veins weren't working to begin with and blood is immediately rerouted to veins which work properly.

Aftercare is the same as with ablation: compression stockings are worn for about a week, and normal, day-to-day activities can start immediately.

Microphlebectomy procedures carry almost no risk of scarring and solve varicose vein problems for good.



Clusters of ugly, purplish spider veins are even easier to treat. Modern skin resurfacing lasers can easily eliminate spider veins completely. No aftercare is necessary, and results are permanent. Laser removal is nearly 100% effective and works on all skin types. As a spider vein treatment it's practically perfect. For slightly larger vein clusters sclerotherapy is often used. This involves injecting tiny amounts of medication, which close down these ugly surface veins which are then reabsorbed without a trace. Sclerotherapy is extremely safe and effective.



LIONS AND TIGERS AND...WARTS? OH MY!

Warts. As soon as you find them, the questions start flowing. "What are they, and how did I get them?" Most importantly, "How do I get rid of them?" At the Beaver Valley Foot Clinic, we are here to put your mind, and your feet, at ease!

A wart, or verruca, is a viral infection of the skin caused by a strain of the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). When found on the bottom of the feet, they are referred to as plantar warts. The virus enters through a crack or cut in the skin. Unfortunately, once you have the virus, it will lay dormant in your system until it decides to make an unwelcome appearance, usually as a hard, callus-like

build-up with black pinpoint dots at the center. Are you ready for some good news? With advances in technology and medication, treatment has never been easier or more effective!

TOPICAL MEDICATION (CANTHARIDIN)

Cantharidin is a liquid solution applied in a podiatrist's office to the most stubborn of warts. Aptly referred to as "Beetle Juice," Cantharidin is derived from a blistering beetle. When applied, it will cause the wart to gently blister over several days. A trained podiatrist will then be able to carefully scrape off the blister and often the wart along with it.

LASER DESTRUCTION (Q-SWITCH OR 1064 LASER)

Laser destruction is a great, nearly pain-free option offering little to no downtime. The laser works by cutting off the blood supply to the wart (those black pinpoint dots at the center) which in turn will kill it. Laser is a popular

choice amongst our youngest patients, as it's relatively pain free, however it can often take multiple treatments to completely kill the viral tumor (wart).



SURGERY (CURETTAGE)

This is not as scary as it sounds. Surgical excision of warts is done right in the office and only requires local anesthesia. Dr. Teimouri, DPM, will use a curette, a tool that

looks like a tiny ice cream scooper, to completely remove the wart tissue. After the wart tissue is completely removed, a time release antimicrobial will be put over the excision site and your foot will be kept wrapped for one week to ensure no bacteria enter the open area.



HOME REMEDIES

While they may seem like the most convenient option, home remedies are often ineffective and may cause more damage than good. Home remedies, such as using duct tape, medicated wart pads, apple cider vinegar, or Vick's VapoRub should never be used without first consulting with a trained podiatrist. If you suspect that you have a plantar

THE INS AND OUTS OF INGROWN TOENAIL TREATMENT

By Casey Armstrong, Registered Radiologic Technologist and Podiatric Assistant It's tempting, we know, but trying to remove an ingrown toenail on your own at home can cause more harm than good.

IN: Scheduling an appointment with your local podiatrist at the first sign of an ingrown toenail.

OUT: Ignoring an ingrown toenail and hoping that it will "go away on its own."

Ingrown nails are the second most common nail problem and often require the attention of a trained podiatrist. Ignoring the problem could ultimately lead to further issues, such as increased pain or even infection.

IN: Having your ingrown nail treated by a podiatrist.

OUT: Getting your toenail clippers out of the medicine cabinet and digging away.

Do not, we repeat, DO NOT attempt to remove an ingrown nail by yourself. Here's why:

- Ingrown toenails often grow a lot further into the flesh of your toe than you realize. You will not be able to remove the entire portion of the embedded nail and will just cause yourself unnecessary suffering.
- 2. Chances are that the tool you'd use to try and dig the nail out with is covered in bacteria. This will lead to an infection, which often becomes severe enough that an oral antibiotic is required.
- 3. FUNGUS! When you dig at your nail, you are causing it to lift away from the nailbed. When the nail lifts away from the bed, even just by 1 mm, fungus has a perfect pathway to get in and cause a fungal infection.

IN: Having a recurrent ingrown nail fixed permanently (matrixectomy) by a trained podiatrist.

OUT: Suffering every month with the same ingrown that just keeps coming back.

During a matrixectomy, your podiatrist will gently cut back a portion of the toenail. Using a Q-tip, a special solution is applied to the nail root, which will prevent the ingrown from returning. Do not worry - your toe will be numb during the procedure, so you should not experience any pain! The remaining nail will look normal, we understand a girl has to wear sandals in the summer!



The general idea behind liposuction is simple: suction away unwanted fat

Is it really any wonder that procedures like this required being put under with general anesthesia and a hospital stay? Or that they often resulted in the "lumpy and bumpy" look?

Keeping these things in mind, here's the very basics on how Water-Jet Liposuction works. The following differences set WAL apart entirely. In the case of WAL, incisions are so small that sutures aren't necessary, which means no removal visit. This also means very minimal scarring, or none at all in most cases. Next diluted numbing medication is pumped into the fat deposit. This not only ensures a pain free procedure, but causes a plumping effect, effectively pushing it away from the tissue surrounding it, making it easier to remove. Known as the tumescent technique, this improvement alone has revolutionized modern liposuction in terms of safety and effectiveness. In the case of WAL, a specialized instrument which generates a highly focused, fan shaped water jet is used. It's basically a water pick, much like the ones dental hygienists use to clean teeth. During the procedure, this fan-shaped jet loosens fat deposits before they're suctioned out, resulting in precise yet gentle removal. Nearby structures veins, arteries, and fibrous bands-remain virtually undamaged. Leaving blood vessels intact is a huge benefit, but of particular interest are the fibrous bands mentioned above. The primary role of these short, tough strips of connective tissue is tightening the skin, which contributes to a smoothly contoured final look.

record of providing a gentle lift to sagging cheeks and an added fullness to thinning lips. The bad news is that they're temporary, only lasting for about 6-9 months. The good news is

that fat grafting to the face can accomplish exactly the same final look as high-end fillers do. A patient's own purified fat is the ideal plumping material, and the results are permanent. The only concern some patients have is the expense, and in almost all cases fat transfer costs less in the long run. Why keep coming back for expensive filler injections when a one-and-done approach works just as well?

Without Water-Jet Assisted Liposuction (WAL), procedures like those described above simply aren't possible. Fat cells are extremely fragile, and harvesting living, undamaged fat cells is the challenge. The second hurdle is separating these cells from unwanted fluid, rinsing them, and purifying them for transfer, all while causing as little damage as possible.

NATURAL BREAST AUGMENTATION:

What makes "perfect" breasts? According to experts, it's more about shape than size. Many plastic and cosmetic surgeons describe "beckoning" breasts, and point to *Transformers* star Megan Fox and Duchess of Cambridge Kate Middleton as examples. Proportionally, 45% of each breast lies above the nipple line while 55% lies below, with the nipples pointing upward at about 45 degrees. AFT makes this sort of sculpting and contouring possible. By applying fat in thin, multiple layers, surgeons performing fat transfer have unprecedented control over the final shape—something silicone and saline implants weren't very good at.

THE BRAZILIAN BUTT-LIFT:

How about the perfect butt? Ultimately it's a matter of personal preference, but the 2010s have been dominated by the "big and round" look. Kim Kardashian and Nicki Minaj come to mind as examples, with most butt-lift patients opting for something equally shapely but less extreme. Traditional implants aren't well suited for buttock enhancement, since they're literally being sat on daily. This isn't a problem with AFT, which provides increased volume and a round, firm, perky final look using a patient's own tissue.

In many ways, the story of Autologous Fat Transfer is the story of Water-Jet Liposuction. Fat removal was never the problem- even the oldest, most primitive techniques were great at this. The

process, however, was so traumatic that extracting live cells from the resulting fluid was nearly impossible.

Laboratory equipment such as filters and centrifuges were used without much success, and in many cases these added steps damaged the remaining cells even further.

Water-Jet Assisted Liposuction uses a highly focused, fan shaped jet of water, so fat deposits are loosened from the tissue then suctioned out using much less force, doing very little damage to individual cells.

Harvested fat is collected in a special container, and undergoes what is known as "floating separation." Undamaged fat cells are very buoyant and rise to the top, while damaged cells, red blood cells, and other unwanted material simply sinks to the bottom. Almost immediately, billions of perfectly intact, healthy cells are ready for implant, wherever they're needed.


EARLOSE REPAIR

Laser Hair Removal:

7 good things to know before treatment

Are you sick of constantly shaving?
Each person's skin and hair type are
slightly different, but chances are you're an
excellent candidate for laser hair removal.
The following information covers the basics.

- 1) It really works. Nine out of ten patients see permanent hair reduction, regardless of the area treated, after 5 to 6 sessions. Yearly touch-ups are rarely needed.
- 2) It's effective on nearly all skin types. There needs to be some contrast, however. The lightest hair on the whitest skin and the darkest hair on the darkest skin are the most challenging combinations.
- 3) It's effective (almost) anywhere. Arms, legs, upper lips, underarms, bikini area, even the hairiest chests and backs are all great candidates. The only area that's off limits is around the eyes these are laser devices, after all.
- 4) Stay out of the sun. Don't come in sunburned, or even lightly tanned for that matter. It's also very important to avoid using self tanner or bronzer three weeks before your treatments. Getting your arms done in the summer? Probably not. Underarms or a Brazilian? Absolutely. Also remember to wear a quality high SPF sunscreen in the following weeks.
- 5) It doesn't hurt. Most people say that treatments feel like a small rubber band being snapped against the skin. That's it!
- 6) Shave the area being treated. It's best to shave the day of the treatment, or at least the night before. Remember that we're targeting pigmented follicles, not active hair. We don't need to see the hair/shaft.
- 7) Don't DIY. At home devices are available, but most dermatologists agree that they aren't intense enough to do the job properly. This typically ends in underwhelming results, which leads to people over-treating themselves during future sessions. Put simply, most people who try this option wish they'd gone to a professional from the start.














It's All About the Follicles:


Laser hair removal and hair growth

If a magical device existed which could remove unwanted hair instantly and permanently, it's a safe bet that most women (and many men) would jump at the opportunity. We're not quite there yet, but modern, 3rd generation hair removal lasers come surprisingly close. After all, why wax, shave, or even pluck when you can target the hair where it grows, at the follicle level? Here's how this type of laser works—and the skin science behind why the device mentioned above isn't possible, yet.

All lasers remove hair by destroying the hair follicles, which are tiny, sac-like glands that produce different colored hair in different people. In an ideal world, one single, perfect laser could zap every unwanted follicle in a single treatment, end of story. The truth, however, isn't that simple. Hair grows in three distinct phases, which is precisely the problem-not every follicle is "on" all of the time.

First comes the active phase, so named because the hair is actively growing from the follicle. It gets its color as it exits the follicle, and grows longer with time. Hair removal lasers target follicles in this stage, destroying the follicle and stopping the growth.

Next comes the shedding phase. The hair is as long as it's going to get, and is simply waiting to fall out. 

By now, chances are that you've heard of laser tattoo removal. If you haven't seriously considered it before, now is the perfect time to take another look. Technology is rapidly catching up with the problem of unwanted tattoos, which brings us to the PicoSure laser by Cynosure, Inc.

It's important to realize that all lasers do not work the same. PicoSure is the world's very first picosecond laser. Quite simply, this means it's capable of removing tattoos in far fewer treatments than older lasers, usually about half. We'll explain how, but first we'll answer the very basic question of why tattoos are permanent to begin with.

Tattoos are made up of.....lnk. We typically think of ink as a liquid, which is only partially correct. On a microscopic level, most professional tattoo inks are made up of billions of pigment particles floating in water. When implanted into the skin with a needle, these particles stay put because they're physically trapped between skin cells—they're literally too big to leave.

All removal lasers work by breaking ink up into smaller fragments which are able to pass out of the skin and ultimately out of the body. The single biggest difference between different types of lasers is how this is accomplished.

Older lasers (basically anything that isn't a picoseconds device like PicoSure) use the photothermal effect—"photo" meaning light, and "thermal" meaning heat. Via this process, ink particles are degraded by rapidly heating them. While this can cause minor damage to surrounding skin, the main problem is that it isn't very efficient. The resulting particles aren't as small as they could be....

PicoSure uses the photomechanical effect—again "photo" means light, while "mechanical" refers to physically shattering ink into extremely tiny particles. Very little heat is produced, but the main advantage lies in particle size. Smaller particles means better results in fewer treatments.

• An MRI or bone scan may also be ordered if necessary Stress fractures are not always immediately evident on X-ray imaging. In fact, they are not usually visible on X-ray imaging at all. What is often seen is a cloud like secondary bone callus that builds around the "stressed" area, not an actual crack or break. Because there is not an obvious break in the bone, stress fractures are notoriously misdiagnosed by medical professionals. If you have any of the above listed symptoms, it is imperative that you visit a trained podiatrist.

WHAT ARE THE TREATMENTS FOR STRESS FRACTURES?

- Rest
- Ice
- NSAIDs, such as Naproxen or Ibuprofen
- Immobilization of the foot with arch supports, a hard soled surgical shoe, or cam walker
- Surgical intervention, although this is very rarely needed Recovery time for stress fractures varies per individual, but typically takes between 6 to 8 weeks depending on severity, but may take up to 16 weeks depending on your activity or poor health.

The achilles tendon, or calcaneal tendon, is a thick band of fibrous tissues that connect the muscle of the calf to the calcaneus, or heel bone. While the Achilles tendon is the strongest tendon in the human body, it's often the site of injury. When inflammation occurs in the tendon, it is referred to as Achilles tendinitis.

WHO IS AT RISK FOR ACHILLES TENDINITIS?

Runners and those who are active are the most at risk. Other risk factors include:

- Age. Achilles tendinitis is more prevalent in those over the age of 30.
- Weight. Increased weight adds more strain on the tendon, causing the tendon to weaken.
- Gender. Sorry gentlemen but you are more likely to develop Achilles Tendinitis than women.

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS OF ACHILLES TENDINITIS?

- Pain along the tendon, often first thing in the morning or with activity
- Weakness or stiffness along the tendon
- Swelling in the back of the heel or lower posterior ankle



- Extracorporeal Shock Wave Therapy (ESWT)

WHAT IS ESWT?

ESWT is a 20 minute non-invasive office procedure that breaks up the chronic inflammatory scar tissue at the Achilles tendon attachment to the heel bone, jumpstarting the body's natural healing mechanisms.

Does a stiff big toe have you down? If so, you may be suffering from something called hallux rigidus. Hallux rigidus is a biomechanical, degenerative arthritic disorder in the joint of the hallux, or big toe. Commonly occurring in those between the ages of 30 and 60, hallux rigidus is one of the most common conditions of the big toe, second only to hallux valgus, or bunion deformities.

SYMPTOMS OF HALLUX RIGIDUS INCLUDE:

- Pain in the big toe, made worse with activity or bending of the toe
- Stiffness in the big toe making it difficult to bend
- Swelling or redness around the joint at the bottom of the the big toe

TREATMENT OPTIONS FOR HALLUX RIGIDUS INCLUDE:

Custom orthotics, not arch supports - Arch supports,
while they are a helpful tool in offering support to the
entire foot, are not effective for the treatment of hallux
rigidus. Custom orthotics, however, when ordered
correctly, create a rocking chair effect which will change
the biomechanics of the joint in the big toe allowing for
comfort when walking

 Injection of steroids - Cortisone is a type of steroid that can be injected into the joint of the big toe in order to reduce the inflammation, which will in turn help alleviate the pain.

- Oral steroids Oral steroids, such as prednisone or methylprednisolone, can be prescribed and taken by mouth in short courses to reduce inflammation and in turn decrease pain.
- NSAIDs NSAIDs, such as ibuprofen and Naproxen are a good option for short term use to calm down any inflammation in the joint.
- Surgery For those who do not get relief from conservative treatments, surgical correction is an option. During surgery, a Board Certified surgically trained podiatrist will remove the arthritic bone from the top of the toe joint that is preventing the toe from moving smoothly.
- K-Laser The K-Laser can be used to stimulate the body's natural healing process in order to reduce the inflammation around the big toe joint.
- Change in Shoes Stiff, wide and deep shoes will decrease irritation to the area.


podiatric surgeon and general podiatrist, Dr. Teimouri has taken specialties including surgical repair of the foot and ankle, diabetic foot care, and advanced wound care protocols. After handling over 200,000 patient visits, she's seen a lot, including common foot conditions gone terribly wrong and one-shot, all or nothing surgeries requiring the utmost finesse. Here's one such story which combines both. It's the case of husband and wife Janet and Robert M., a



couple with a history of terrible luck in terms of foot health, who had both developed podiatry

problems years in the making. It's also a story about how both patients' conditions developed into cases of chronic pain, something most people only associate with neck and back injuries and conditions like chronic migraines. However, as any veteran podiatrist can tell you, this is a fairly common occurrence. "I see it happen to people all the time," says Dr. Teimouri.

Robert's case certainly didn't start out with excruciating foot pain. About 6 years prior, before developing any severe symptoms, he had had several minor procedures to improve circulation in his left leg. He had previously had a small ulcer on his ankle, and the treatments did seem to help. The ulcer went away, and things returned to normal.



"He had problems with ulcers before," said his wife Janet, "but then 3 years ago, right out of the blue, this happened." Another ulcer had appeared on top of his second toe, which quickly grew and began to spread into the space between the adjacent big toe. This was an unusual place for an ulcer, as most tend to occur at the very bottom of the ankle, which had happened to Robert in the past. Soon the ulcer had become quite severe, and its location ensured that Robert felt pain with every step. "We went to 5 or 6 doctors before ending up at a wound care center... For two years. Nothing helped. Then our primary care doctor referred us to Dr. Teimouri."

"She didn't have 1000 questions. She had clearly seen this before and had 100%

confidence," continued Janet, and intensive therapy was started immediately. Robert had circulation problems to begin with, and in any type of wound, especially ulcers, complete healing can't happen without proper blood flow. In this case the skin around the ulcer was so damaged that it required a specialty collagen coating which gave the new skin a framework to grow onto, which it slowly but surely did. "It's been about a month, and it's so much better. We've been together for 10 years, and his feet have never been better. It sounds extreme, but Dr. Tina really did give him his hope back."

making the operation a double surgery. "Fortunately I've got experience doing bunions," says Dr. Teimouri, who has performed well over 4000 similar bunion and/or hammertoe surgeries. After 23 years of serving Beaver, Allegheny Counties and the North Hills area, the Beaver Valley Foot Clinic has expanded to four locations. It's grown to become one of the largest private podiatry practices in Western Pennsylvania, yet keeps its focus firmly on its roots-primary care family podiatry. "I'm basically still a small town podiatrist," says Dr. Teimouri, "just like I've always been."

"I would travel to Chicago to see her if I had to, now that I know how good she is."

In the meantime, Janet had been struggling with foot pain of her own for her entire adult life, in this case caused by bunions and a hammertoe. "I barely got out of bed and I was already in pain." She had been considering surgery for years, and after Robert's recent experience she felt comfortable enough to take action. Now, after a successful surgery, Janet is elated to say that her foot "looks like a normal foot again," minus the constant pain.

It's important to realize that a bunion isn't just an unsightly and uncomfortable bump. It's actually a joint deformity, and most bunion surgeries involve removing part of the toe joint, which is never simple even in the best of circumstances. In Janet's case things were further complicated by a second joint deformity, a severe hammertoe, effectively

GOUT: Facts vs. Fiction

OUCH! Even if you don't know much about gout, you might have heard that it hurts.....a lot. As any gout sufferer will tell you, there's nothing like a gout attack, and the following scenario is a good illustration. At about 2 AM, our imaginary patient is awakened by an excruciating pain in his big toe. He's never felt anything like it, and quite frankly he's terrified. It feels like a nail is being driven into the large joint where the toe meets the foot. Even the slightest touch of the blanket covering the toe in question causes agony as he struggles to get out of bed. He throws on the lights and discovers that the base of his big toe is swollen and bright red, nearly the color of the cherry on top of an ice cream sundae.

He decides not to call 911, yet, and his next move is a quick internet search. Several minutes later he learns that he's just had his first attack of gout, also known as gouty arthritis. It affects about 2% of the population, making it one of the four most common types of arthritis, with only osteoarthritis (OA), rheumatoid arthritis (RA), and psoriatic arthritis (PsA) occurring more often. This form of arthritis isn't well understood by many patients, and half-truths and complete falsehoods abound.

Only wealthy people who eat lots of rich foods get gout. FALSE (completely)

Formerly known as "the king's disease," gout was thought to affect only those described above. Admittedly, diets heavy on red meat, wine, and decadent desserts do contribute to gout, but it's not a requirement. When digested, these foods produce chemicals called purines,

which do indeed set a person up for gout. It's equally true, however, that "healthy" diets rich in seafood, beans, and even spinach can lead to extremely high purine levels.

It only attacks the big toe.

False (completely)

Gout goes for the great toe only about half of the time. It also commonly occurs in the ankles, knees, elbows, wrists, and fingers.

It only affects men.

False (with a twist)

It's easy to see how this half-truth got started. Gout does indeed strike 10 times as many men as women....until they hit menopause. According to noted expert Dr. Herbert Baraf, professor of clinical medicine at George Washington University Medical Center, "new cases of gout in men and women tend to equal out after age 60 or so."

Gout is caused by too much uric acid in the blood.

True (sort of)

Technically speaking, high levels of uric acid in the blood won't harm you one bit. In fact, many healthy, gout-free people have elevated levels. It's only when uric acid crystals form inside the affected joints that gout comes about. Why this happens in some people and not others isn't well understood.

Once you've got it, you're stuck with gout for life.

True (in the past)

This used to be true, more or less. Once you've had your first attack, you're much more likely to suffer attacks in the future. Today, however, several medications exist which manage uric acid levels in the blood so effectively that many patients never have to deal with gout again.

As you can see, gout isn't what most people think it is. Regardless, what you really need to know is that if you've got it, we can help. Podiatrists are the type of physicians who treat patients with gout most often, so they're your first, best bet.

Treating Corns, Calluses and Painful Hammertoes

Like most conditions seen by podiatrists, corns and calluses have different "levels" of treatment. This least-invasive to most-invasive approach is found in all branches of medicine and applies to all conditions, no matter how simple or complex. In podiatry, corns are the classic example; treatments range from simply buying different shoes to full-fledged surgery. If you've got corns or calluses that bother you enough to seek treatment, here's what you can expect from your podiatrist—or podiatric surgeon, if that's what's needed. Chronic foot pain is never normal. Not

surprisingly, most people who "just live with it" are those who don't have a podiatrist.

Corns and calluses look different and appear on different areas of the foot, but both form in the same way. They are essentially a protective response—over time, excessive rubbing causes the skin to

proprietation pr

thicken and form a protective pad. If this pad is flat, broad-based, and found on the bottom of the foot then it's usually a callus. If it's a small, hard bump

found on pressure points such as the side of the pinky toe, then it's probably a corn. Both are common, and both cause a surprising array of problems. They're also very treatable, and are among the most frequently seen problems by podiatrists everywhere.

Especially for corns, the first thing you'll likely be told is to buy different shoes. Unfortunately, this only works some of the time, for some patients. The perfect (and almost only entirely successful) example of this is professional and style-conscious women who stop wearing high heels. In cases like this, anything short of stopping daily wear will practically guarantee worsening pain.

Calluses typically cause many fewer problems than corns.

They tend to be flat and rub less against the inside of the shoe. Light callusing causes almost no symptoms, and is one of the very few cases where home remedies will suffice—pumice stones are cheap, safe, and effective (if you are not diabetic).

Some level of callusing is normal and healthy, and only the very



thickest cause pain and require treatment. These problem calluses are almost always found on the heel or ball of the foot, and can be very deep, painful, and are often dry, cracked, and fissured.

Calluses like this are usually found on patients with tinea pedis (athlete's foot). The other main group where this is found are diabetics. These patients suffer more foot problems than anyone else, and it's essential that they see a podiatrist: the risk of infection and damage to healthy surrounding skin is simply too great. Podiatrists use prescription creams much stronger than store brands, which often contain urea and cause dead skin cells to gradually slough off.

For any podiatric condition, surgery is always the option of last resort. It's only considered when all other options fail. Corns themselves rarely require surgery, but severe cases of hammertoe deformity (crooked bent toes) almost always do. The textbook case of hammertoe appears as a permanent "kink" in the joints of the long toe next to the big toe—it's basically clawed over in a way that ensures excessive rubbing. No other group experiences corns and

calluses which are more severe, and more resistant to treatment. This usually means any type of closed-toe shoe is extremely uncomfortable, and can even limit a patient's

ability to walk.

Correcting a hammertoe is fairly simple. It's a 15 minute office based procedure; safe, effective, and the results are usually excellent. Patients can walk right away.

Diabetic Neuropathy: Causes, Symptoms, and Treatments.

Diabetes is a complicated disease. It's much more than high blood sugar, and treating it is more than taking a handful of pills or an insulin shot. It affects the heart and blood vessels, as well as the liver, kidneys, and especially the nerves, blood supply, and skin of the feet! Early treatment is important to good foot care. Yearly foot checks are recommended.

Here's why. Over long periods of time elevated levels of sugar in the blood can damage blood vessels, particularly the smallest arteries- capillaries. Capillaries carry blood to every cell in the body. Likely due to system-wide inflammation, micro-tears appear in capillary walls, which allows cholesterol to deposit there. This in turn causes these arteries to narrow and in some cases close down completely. Poor circulation in any region can cause damage there.

If left untreated, small wounds on a diabetic's toes which could easily have been healed by a Podiatrist can become gangrenous and need to be amputated.

A patient's nerves are easily damaged by poor blood supply, which brings us to a







cluster of symptoms known as diabetic neuropathy. Not all diabetics will develop this type of nerve damage, but for those that do it's usually their most painful symptom. Diabetic neuropathy can technically happen in any part of the body, but almost always occurs in the feet—since they're the furthest from the heart, anything which causes circulation problems tends to affects them first.

What are the symptoms of diabetic neuropathy? Patients frequently report: numbness (sometimes including a complete lack of sensation), tingling, burning, a feeling that the skin is "crawling," and sharp, needle-like pains that are often excruciating. On a more bizarre note, some patients report that they feel like they're wearing socks, even when they're barefoot. Symptoms can range from merely annoying to

outright debilitating.

It's essential for all diabetics to have a podiatrist. No other group of patients experience more foot problems, or have a higher risk of complications. It is more treatable than ever before. Medications, pain creams, specialty inserts, and modern orthopedic footwear form the backbone of diabetic neuropathy treatment today. It's also important to note that better, more advanced treatments are becoming available every year, so ask your podiatrist. For many patients, a state of near-remission is possible.

Heel Pain, Plantar Fasciitis and Fallen Arches:Orthotics and Inserts for Everyday Foot Care.



If you wear shoes, you should also be wearing custom orthotics, or at the very least a pair of high-quality inserts. Most people are thinking of drug-store inserts, which are basically nothing more than glorified padding. On the whole they completely ignore problems with foot and gait mechanics.

Proper orthotics might look much like their drugstore counterparts, but how they work is entirely different.

Orthotics are semi-rigid shoe inserts, and their primary purpose is to provide support, not padding. They accomplish 3 specific goals: First is correcting the mechanical issues of each foot, for instance propping up a fallen arch, or inflamed tendon. Second, they protect feet from stress fractures due to abnormal motion and loading. Finally, orthotics compensate for unequal leg length. Only when all of these issues are addressed will a person walk correctly, i.e. without causing themselves foot or ankle problems with every step.

As a non-invasive option, orthotics are often the fastest, easiest, and most efficient solution for a wide array of foot problems. It's a rough analogy, but orthotics are basically for feet what braces are to teeth—both correct mechanical problems and stop them from getting worse. Anyone can benefit from a good pair of orthotics, from the very elderly with limited mobility to elite professional athletes.

But here's the good news. In all of these cases, it's now possible to get all of the benefits of a full-fledged cosmetic procedure in a single in-office visit, with almost no downtime. In fact the only real downside is that it's not permanent. This type of non-surgical procedure is made possible by the miracle of dermal fillers such as Restylane Lyft, Juvéderm Voluma, or Radiesse which have arguably been the industry's biggest leap forward since wrinkle-relaxers such as Botox or Dysport.

Much as it sounds, dermal fillers are great at "filling in," meaning that they add volume to the face wherever it's needed. They're perfect for firming up sagging cheeks, plumping up thinning lips, and filling in deep wrinkles and hollows. Now consider what this means for the nose, bearing in mind that all of the situations described above are problems of shape.

The "hook nose" is the most clear cut example. In this case, the bridge of the nose is so prominent that it appears as a large bump that makes the rest of the nose appear to curve downward. A trained injector can add small amounts of filler like Juvéderm above and below the bridge, giving it the desired straighter appearance almost instantly. It's hard to overemphasize that the end result is virtually identical to traditional surgery. Ultimately there's no more bump, and the nose appears straight when viewed from the side. In the case of a crooked nose the same principles apply, just add some high-quality filler to the opposite side to create a more even appearance.

What are the benefits? It's almost completely non-invasive, which means it's almost entirely safe. Infection is possible with any type of injection, but it's extremely rare and usually minor. It's also (much) less

expensive than standard rhinoplasty—usually only about 20-40% of the cost. Additionally, it has two benefits which make it completely unique: it lets a patient "try on" a procedure before committing to more permanent surgery, and can even correct a previous botched nose job.

How about the drawbacks? With products like Juvéderm ultra and Restylance Silk results typically last 8-12 months, while longer lasting products such as Radiesse, Voluma and Lyft deliver for up to $1^{1}/2$ years.

Laser Spider Vein Removal

How happy are you with how your legs look, right now? If your legs are crisscrossed with unsightly veins then you probably dread wearing shorts, and we've got a treatment that can help. The large, thick, rope-like veins winding their way down your legs are known as varicose veins, and they're not easy to miss. These are often found on the calves and the backs of the thighs, and thanks to advances in minimally invasive vein procedures, they've become fairly easy to treat (see article on page 16).

Reticular veins are smaller, and are often thought of as varicose veins just waiting to happen. For most, these smaller veins are much easier to deal with than full-sized varicose veins using a technique called sclerotherapy (see article to the right).

The smallest, and often the most personally unappealing, veins found anywhere on the legs are technically known as telangiectasias, but are almost always called spider veins. These purple, blue, and occasionally reddish networks of tiny veins can be found on many areas of the body, not just on the calves and thighs but also on the sides of the nose or cheeks, and have a distinctive web-like appearance, hence their name. At their worst, they don't even look like clusters of veins anymore. instead resembling large patches of permanent bruising. Fortunately, thanks to cosmetic skin lasers, they're now the easiest to treat of all the common vein conditions.

In many ways, spa-grade medical lasers are the poster children for the modern health and beauty industry. They're quick, versatile, and what they do is cosmetically miraculous. Put very simply, if it's on the skin and has any color to it—tattoo ink and hair follicles, for instance, or even freckles—lasers can reduce or remove it entirely.

This includes spider veins. One of the very things which make them so dreadful looking also makes them quite easy to remove, namely their typical bluish, purplish color. Laser removal of spider veins has become so simple that it's widely regarded as a "slam-dunk" procedure, one that's both highly effective and entirely non-invasive.

Sclerotherapy for By Steven M. Crotzer Larger Veins

Laser removal of spider veins is quick, safe, and permanent, so what's the drawback? There really isn't one, but there is a size limit. True spider veins are tiny, only about one millimeter across. This is about the width of a mechanical pencil lead, and is the largest size even the best lasers on the market today can

handle. Veins which are too large to be "spiders" and too small to qualify as varicose are known as reticular veins, and these awkward, in-between sizes require a treatment all their own.

Sclerotherapy, or simply "sclero," fits this bill perfectly, and bridges the gap between lasers and minimally invasive vein removal. Right now it's

the gold-standard treatment for getting rid of reticular veins and smaller varicose veins permanently, safely, and almost as quickly as lasers do—in about ten minutes, as opposed to instantly.

Like most good techniques or treatments, sclerotherapy is simple. It does exactly what it's supposed to do, and nothing else. Tiny amounts of specialized medications known (unsurprisingly) as sclerosants or sclerosing agents are injected directly into the veins being treated, and react with both the blood inside the veins and the vein walls themselves. The walls begin to thicken, and soon close down entirely. The overall appearance improves immediately, since no more blue or purplish blood is left inside the vein. Over the next two weeks the vein is absorbed back into the body completely.

It's important to note that laser treatments and sclerotherapy are complementary treatments. What laser treatments can't do sclerotherapy usually can, and vice versa. For most patients, this means legs which look exactly as if the veins were never there to begin with.

Vein disease is extremely common, and affects a staggering 30 million Americans each year, which is just under 10% of the population. To put this into perspective, only about 29 million Americans suffer from diabetes. This number is astounding. and realistically the incidence of vein disease will keep climbing as the Baby Boomer generation continues to age. Specifically we're talking about something called Chronic Venous Insufficiency (CVI) of major leg veins, and the most common symptoms include night cramps, charley horses, restless leg syndrome, aching, heavy, tired legs which tend to swell, especially around the ankles. Visible symptoms often include large, ropey varicose veins, as well as unsightly clusters of purplish spider veins located anywhere

on the legs.

where modern medicine is clearly winning, and everyone likes a success story.

In any surgical procedure, simple is good. It shouldn't have "side effects" such as a long, painful recovery time, damage to surrounding tissue, or scarring. Note that the goal of any successful vein procedure is to literally shut the diseased vein down entirely. Since the affected vein isn't working properly, blood begins to collect in the legs, which causes all of the swelling and symptoms associated with vein disease. Once such veins are closed down, blood is immediately rerouted to nearby working veins, and circulation is immediately improved, safely and permanently.

This made sense to the medical community, and adhesives designed specifically to treat leg vein conditions were soon developed.

The beauty of the vein glue approach lies in its simplicity. This technique is by far the least invasive of its type. First, ultrasound imaging is used to locate the leg vein to be treated, and a miniaturized catheter (a hollow, flexible tube) is placed inside the vein. Small amounts of glue are then delivered along the length of the vein,

sealing it shut—and that's it, problem solved. Normal activities can be started almost immediately.


